Public Relations

Publishing Commons

This environment is for hosting publication venues using systems developed externally and serves a mostly public relations function.

Development

Frontend Commons

This is a commons for smaller web services frontends as the production endpoint for an environment pipeline designed to develop those services. This pipeline only hosts frontends.

Backend Commons

This is a commons for smaller web services backends as the production endpoint for an environment pipeline designed to develop those services. This pipeline only hosts backends.

SCM

(**source.surroindustries.com**)

The source code repository. Hosts a portion of the source code for SURRO and SILO projects.

CI

There is a build and deployment server that watches repositories in the SCM for merges and deploys to lower environments. Once approved, these services can be deployed to their production environment.
